Zion national park guided hiking tours

You have to dress in layers here, the weather can get a little chilly at night. To make the West Rym Trail as a night trip you'll need a backpack. Bring a space blanket for cover in case you get caught there without planning. You will even be able to enjoy the morning with the wind. Pack extra food and a water filter. In case you're over, want to be able to purge yours. Canyoneering equipment is available for rent in Springdale. A tent is a great investment, so get a decent one, easy enough pod but spacious enough to camp the cars. Good sleeping bags and half-sleepers are just as important. A three-person oven is useful for camping in a car, but a small backpacker oven is better for dilation trips. Robust hiking boots are a must, along with good socks - something people skimp on. Liner socks save you from blisters and if you haven't tried them you should. Water shoes are essential. You'll spend 17 miles in the water -- you want protection. If you're walking on the Nares Trail, you can rent water shoes and hiking boots in Springdale. Definitely bring a digital camera with a lot of memory cards -- you'd be surprised how many photos you take. Bring sunscreen, insect repellent and a first aid kit -- just in case. Big tip: There's always water with you. Even if you don't travel, the warm weather can dry up. It is, unsurprisingly, designed in the same rustic-trendy way as most other lodges in the area, but it leans towards the more upmarket end of the spectrum. Room types vary from king, queen and double studios with kitchenettes to larger suites with full kitchens featuring various amenities ranging from jet baths and private patios to balconies and fireplaces. There is a pool on the premises, and within a 3-minute walk is Zion Canyon Village with restaurants, a brewery pub, shops and even a cinema. The property also operates a free shuttle service inviting guests to Springdale city centre, 1.5 km away, where additional entertainment can be found. For those who wish to be close to both the park and the facilities outside it, you can beat this option. 02 of 09 Courtesy of Zion Lodge National Park When it comes to hotels in Zion National Park, it's the only one actually within the park's boundaries. Naturally, if you want to be close to nature, it doesn't get any better than Zion Lodge — which is also one of the best hotels in the area. Originally built in 1925, the historic main lodge was destroyed by fire in 1966 and rebuilt within four months in the same low country style, and several chalets were built across the property for more private accommodation. Today, there are 125 hotel rooms, suites with kitchenettes, and cabins with a gas fireplace, decorated in the classic national park style (think: forests and earthy tones) with modern features like air conditioning, Wi-Fi and cable TV. Facilities at the property are somewhat limited, with on-site dining options limited to red rock grill throughout the year and the seasonal Rock Dome Café. Although there is no pool, you are within walking distance of hiking and horseback riding trails, making it ideal for a nature lover who wants to maximise time in the park. 03 of 09 Courtesy under Fabric Zion If you're interested in a camping farm but you're not quite ready to wear it down, consider glamping in Zion Fabric. The seasonal camp, open from March to November, covers 196 acres near the eastern border of Zion National Park, making access to the park easy. However, it's a remote location - it's about 30 minutes for springdale city centre entertainment - but it's certainly part of the property's allure. Decorated in a tent style, all units range from private bathrooms with running water to safari-style tents with shared (but luxurious) facilities suitable for at least seven guests. There is an on-site restaurant serving breakfast and dinner, and also offers picnic lunches for your adventures in the park or at the property. Under Canvas A variety of activities can be arranged, from safaris to paddling boards to yoga classes and massages. As long as you're still as close to nature as a person can get, you'll also be surrounded by the velvety comfort of creatures. 04 of 09 Courtesy of La Quinta Inn & Suites La Verkin While most places to stay near Zion National Park are in Springdale, just outside the park's main gates, prices can be a little high there. For those on a budget, it's best to go a little further, like la Verkin town, about a 30-minute drive from Springdale. The hotel offers a great stay for the price - it has an outdoor pool and gym, as well as free breakfast. Plus, it's pet-friendly! Unlike the lodges closer to the park, the hotel is decorated in a modern style with purple and yellow accents, and they have added touches like microwaves, mini fridges and flat-screen TVs. While the city of La Venkin doesn't have so many activities as Springdale, there are a number of restaurants and shops in town to keep you busy when you're not hiking the trails in Zion. Proceed to 5 of 9 below. 05 out of 9 courtesy of Mount Zion Farm The Zion Mountains Farm is not just a hotel - it's actually a functioning 3,000-acre farm that gives guests a real Western experience. There are 53 rustic chalets, each with full kitchenettes or kitchens, plus individual features that are available for the unit, such as saunas and private massage rooms. Since the farm is a bit out of the way of some of the main attractions - it's just over a 30-minute drive from Springdale and the shuttle to the main entrance of Zion National Park (though the east entrance is just a six-minute drive away) - there's a restaurant from the farm to a table featuring ingredients grown or grown on site, from vegetables from the organic gardens and marine greenhouses to food from the farm-educated sea model. Activities revolve around a horseback riding tour of the farm, but the property also provides guides to take guests to canoning, mountain biking, fly fishing and hiking. Not only is Zion nearby, but the national park is coral-pink sand dunes, which is definitely worth a visit of its own. Set on 4,000 acres of land, Zion Ponderosa Resort prepares for on-site entertainment. Although it has, of course, hiking trails that lead straight to the east side of the national park, if you want to leave the property and explore what is ostensibly the most popular attraction in the area. The resort offers a staggering number of activities to try for children and adults alike, from more classic Western enjoyment such as horseback riding to ziplining pumping adrenaline and bungee trampolines. There is also a mini golf course, a shooting range, and an indoor-outdoor climbing wall, as well as all kinds of sports fields. For guests with additional healthy opinions, there are also spa and yoga classes. As for Lodging, Ponderusa offers all sorts of styles, from caravan companies and shared summer camp-style chalet facilities to private mountain houses, meaning each group of guests can choose the type of stay that suits their style. 07 of 09 Courtesy of Springhill Suites National Park is a landmark so the nearest major airport is in Las Vegas - more than a three-hour drive away - the Zion National Park area may not be a popular choice for business meetings. However, if you are in town at work, this hotel has 3,300 square feet of meeting space to accommodate corporate events and retreats. If you are on a family holiday but still need to work, the hotel also offers free (strong) Wi-Fi and work desks in every room. As suggested by the hotel's name, the accommodation is decorated in a suite style. All rooms are decorated in a contemporary style with subtle movements to the western location of the stay, which are associated with wooden accent walls, but the aesthetic is more modern than rustic. Regarding the facilities, there is a pool and hot tub, a convenience store, and a free breakfast to make your stay more comfortable. The hotel is also near all of Springdale's restaurants and bars, if you're looking for a little more entertainment. One of the best is the Red Rock Inn, which has eight individually designed suites and cottages named after famous features or trails in Zion National Park, which is less than a mile away. A recent renovation saw the update of some rooms, which feature a modern Western look with patterned rugs and fur-like throws, and range in size from king-size beds to duplexes with full kitchens and a sofa bed. Like some of the other inns in Springdale, Red Rock collaborated with Oscar's Coffee for a free breakfast (it's just a few houses down). In the evenings, guests can have tea and watch the sun set on the inn's hilltop patio. Each has its own style, but they all fall under the broad category of country chic with floral fabrics, iron bed frames, and exposed wooden beams all over. Breakfast is served daily at the nearby Oscar's Cafe, but the inn is also within walking distance of springdale city centre's restaurants.
